BRHS was formed in 1998 to help find homes for stray animals. Prior to 1998 the majority of animals coming into animal control had to be euthanized. That is very rare now for socially adoptable animals.

We presently reside in a rented space across from the Brookings Airport.

- Protect animals by finding them their forever homes through an extensive adoption outreach program
- Educate the community about companion animals and promote responsible pet care and pet ownership
- Promote the reduction of pet overpopulation through spay/neuter educations and programs.
